### Carpentry:

**September 24th - 28th: Monday - Friday, 8am-4:30pm**

This 40-hour introductory training covers the basics of carpentry and trades math. Accurate reading and use of a tape measure, 3-4-5 method of layout, and safe use of power tools. Using skills learned in class, participants build the following projects: hammer, saw & nail, a sawhorse, a foot stool, and a set of stairs to a platform. Construction site education, safety, and carpenter expectations will also be covered.

### Weatherization with OSHA 10:

**November 13th - 16th: Tues - Friday, 8am to 4:30pm**

This 32 hour introductory training covers; building science, health and safety, theory of blower door use, including general air sealing, and attic weatherization. Training will also cover theory of identifying specific home weatherization problems, and doing weatherization work safely.
