Training for Jobs that Pay!

Flux Core Arc Welding:

January 15th - 26th: Tuesday and Thursday nights from 6-9pm and Saturdays from 9am - 4pm

This 24-hour introductory training covers vertical and horizontal wire feed welding, oxygen and acetylene cutting, safe use of hands-on tools and materials, welding practices, joint design identification, fit-up and electrode selection. Hands-on welding practice.

Blueprint Reading & Trades Math:

February 26th - March 9th: Tuesday and Thursday nights from 6 - 9pm and Saturdays from 9am - 5pm

This 26-hour introductory training covers basic residential print reading skills, abbreviations, plot plans, foundation plans, floor plans, exterior elevations, section views, details, framing plans, door & window schedules, finish schedules, and specifications. Trades math includes solving with ratio and proportion, fractions, decimals, and the 3-4-5 layout method.

Carpentry: April 1st - 5th: Monday - Friday, 8am - 5pm

This 40-hour introductory training covers the basics of carpentry and trades math. Accurate reading and use of a tape measure, 3-4-5 layout method, and safe use of power tools. Hands-on portion includes building a sawhorse, a foot stool, and a set of stairs to a platform. Construction site education, safety, and carpenter expectations are also covered.

FREE CONSTRUCTION TRAINING CLASSES

Residential Framing:

February 19th-22nd, Monday-Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm

Training covers wall layout using 16 and 24 inch layout, design placement & use of wall framing components, conventional roof framing techniques for wood rafters and ceiling joist, and methods of layout.

Ironwork and Welding:

March 18th-22nd, Monday-Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm

Training covers the basics of rebar, steel erection and welding used in the Ironworker Trade. Stick welding (SMAW) and oxy acetylene cutting will be covered.

Power Tools:

March 18th-22nd, Monday-Thursday, 8:00am to 4:30pm

Power Tools training will cover proper safety, operation and use for a variety of power tools used in the construction industry, allowing students to develop proper safety habits and power tool operation skills. Students will construct several small projects or complete tasks using various power tools. *Circular Saw, Power Drill, Jigsaw Router, Impact Driver, Sander, Compound Miter Saw, Pneumatic Nailer, Laser Level, Air Compressor, along with other construction related power tools.

General Construction:

March 18th-22nd, Monday-Friday, 8am-4:30pm

Training covers lite version of general construction field assessment, trenching and back filling, sack and patch training and the hazards of silica in construction, hand signal/voice command training for cranes and forklifts and additional training as future construction craft laborers candidates.

LOOK FOR THE WOMEN IN THE TRADES TAB

Requirements:

- * Apply online.
- * High School Diploma or GED
- * Must have paid into the Alaska Unemployment insurance in the last 5 years
- * Must bring S.S. Card to first day of class if accepted (U.S. Citizen & Alaskan Resident)
- * Copy of valid Alaska Driver's License for at least 30 days
- * Proof of a minimum one (1) year driver license and copy of valid Alaska Driver's License for at least 30 days with Clean Driving Record for up to the last 5 years.
- * Must be an Alaska Resident for 30 days prior to application and intend to make Alaska your permanent home.
- * Must have original or Certified COPY of Birth Certificate or a current U.S. Passport
- * Must be able to PASS Drug and Alcohol Screening Test and USDOT Physical to obtain Physical Card
- * Must also be able to obtain and pass a Federal background Check - required with acceptance into the Teamsters
- * Must meet the Construction Truck Driver Apprenticeship Requirements.
- * Must be 19 years old by September 9, 2019
- * WorkKeys Test Score of 4 or higher

INDUSTRY TRAINING**

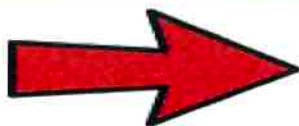


- OSHA 10 is a ten hour general construction safety course. OSHA stands for Occupational Safety and Health Administration; a national certificate that does not expire.
- Medic First Aid is a 4-hour training that provides the participant with a 2-year Medic First Aid/AED/CPR card.
- Scaffold User/Fall protection is an 8 hour course that covers: OSHA standards, awareness of, placement, erecting, and dismantling of scaffolding, fall protection requirements, and what a competent person does.

- Seniors will be given preference for this training; applications considered on a first come, first served basis.
